What is the Global Status Report?

REN21's **Renewables Global Status Report (GSR)**, first released in 2005, grew out of an effort to comprehensively capture, the full status of renewable energy worldwide. Over the years, the GSR has expanded in scope and depth, in parallel with tremendous advances in renewable energy markets and industries. The report is a true collaborative effort of several authors, REN21 Secretariat staff and Steering Committee members, regional research partners, and more than 400 individual contributors and reviewers; and has become the most frequently referenced report on renewable energy business and policy, serving a wide range of audiences.
